### Regular services

The following regular services are held at St Peter's Church. There will be changes and extra services during Holy Week (before Easter) and at Christmas.

- Sunday 8.30am Said Eucharist
- Sunday 10am Sung Eucharist

- Tuesday Baby and Toddler 'ABC' communion service
